Our WHS objectives are:

- Ensure the physical and mental health and safety of our workers.
- Comply with all current legislative and contract requirements related to WHS to provide a safe and healthy work environment and, when required, comply with our clients' WHSMS requirements.
- Ensure that WHS considerations are not compromised by other business objectives.

We will achieve these objectives by:

- Ensuring that systems are in place to effectively manage health and safety.
- Implementing risk management processes to identify and manage hazards in consultation with workers.
- Ensuring that work activities are carried out by competent, suitably trained people, and providing training as required.
- Ensuring that all staff, subcontractors and third parties understand that they have a personal responsibility to conduct their work in a safe manner.
- Maintaining WHS performance targets to continually improve our management of health and safety.
- Communicating and consulting with all workers on WHS matters.
- Implementing processes to identify mental health concerns and providing support as required.
- Purchasing company vehicles with an ANCAP 4 star rating or higher.
